### **PARENT INVOLVEMENT POLICY**

- Parents shall receive information in a timely manner.
- Salk Elementary School academic performance data and individual student progress will be made available to parents.
- Parents shall expect timely responses to their suggestions and concerns.
- Salk Elementary School shall provide opportunities for participation of all parents with limited English proficiency or disabilities.
