

Salk Elementary Uniform Dress Code

ALL CLOTHING IS IN SOLID COLORS.

NO STRIPES, PATTERNS, GRAPHIC DESIGNS OR LETTERING.

EXCEPTION: Salk T-Shirts

- **SHIRTS – Solid School Colors**

- **Colors**

- Classic Red (NOT maroon)
- Navy Blue (NOT royal blue, NOT light blue)
- White

- **Style**

- Oxford or Polo
- Short or long sleeved

- **Extra Instructions**

- Emblems or words are NOT allowed. (i.e. having a Polo symbol on the shirt is NOT allowed)
- Long sleeve shirts worn under short sleeve shirts must be either the school red, navy blue, or white
- Shirts MUST have a collar, not simply a t-shirt.

- **SWEATERS/SWEATER VESTS/SWEATSHIRTS – Solid School Colors**

- **Style**

- Sweaters, sweater vests and sweatshirts are all allowed.

- **Extra Instructions**

- May NOT have a hood on the sweater or sweatshirt

- **SALK T-SHIRT - Can ONLY be worn on Friday**

- **PANTS/CAPRIS**

- **Colors**

- Khaki
- Navy Blue
- Black

- **Style**

- Flat paneled or pleated

- **Extra Instructions**

- MUST BE IN GOOD REPAIR – NO TEARS OR HOLES.

- **SHORTS/SKORTS/SKIRTS – Solid School Colors**

- Khaki
- Navy Blue
- Black

- **Style**

- Flat paneled or pleated

- **Extra Instructions**

- Must be at least 3 inches from the knee.
 - Must be in good repair with no frayed ends (i.e. NO CUT OFFS)
- **JUMPER - Solid School Colors**
 - **Color**
 - Khaki
 - Navy Blue
 - **Extra Instructions**
 - If the jumper does not have sleeves, a uniform shirt **MUST** be worn underneath the jumper.
 - Must extend to at least 3 inches above the knee.
- **POLO STYLE DRESSES – Solid School Colors**
 - **Color**
 - Classic Red (NOT maroon)
 - Navy Blue (NOT royal blue, NOT light blue)
 - Khaki
 - **Extra Instructions**
 - Must extend to at least 3 inches from the knees
- **FOOTWEAR - CLOSED TOE ONLY (no sandals or flip flops)**
- **ACCESSORIES/FASHION**
 - Scarves **MAY NOT** be worn around the head or the neck unless the scarf is part of a religious preference.
 - Any jewelry, hair design or ornamentation must not be a distraction** to the educational process.
 - Hair color is to be of a ‘natural’ color (no, pink, blue, classic red, green, etc...dyed color).
 - Hair extensions are to be the same color as the student’s hair color.
- **MISCELLANEOUS**
 - Shirts **MUST** be tucked in.
 - Students may wear any jacket or hoodie to school, but it must be kept in their locker and not worn during the school day.
- **FRIDAYS ONLY**
 - May wear Salk T-Shirt or uniform shirt
 - May wear Jeans
 - Must be blue denim jeans (not black, red, green, yellow or any other color than blue denim).
 - Blue jean denim shorts are acceptable (of appropriate length of no more than 3 inches above the knee) and of appropriate fit (cannot be too saggy or too tight).

*Tulsa Public Schools (TPS) Policy 2601 defines the school district’s dress code as stated:

“Individual schools, via their respective school shared decision-making councils or school improvement committees may, upon approval by the principal, impose more strict dress code requirements than those set forth herein. However, all schools must meet the standards set forth in this policy as the minimum requirement. Schools shall publish any and all additional requirements/expectations relative to student dress. Students and their parents/guardians have the responsibility to be aware of any school specific dress codes and to conform to those requirements after the school has provided reasonable notice.”
